If you have an idea for a project, describe it in no more than three pages. Make your financial request reasonable and defensible. Please go to our website for instructions on how to submit your letter through our online application portal.

If your project is shortlisted, you'll be invited to submit a more detailed proposal. Atkinson's Board of Directors will make final decisions about grants no later than the end of the year.
